



EXTRAIT DE PÉTITION
(Article 64 du Règlement)

Je dépose l'extrait d'une pétition adressée à l'Assemblée nationale, signée par vingt-cinq pétitionnaires.

Désignation : Citoyens et citoyennes du Québec.

Les faits invoqués sont les suivants :

CONSIDERING THAT, in Quebec, the situation concerning pets is truly unacceptable and that the Animal Health Protection Act (P-42) is not properly applied;

CONSIDERING THAT the Quebec government has the responsibility and the moral duty to ensure the protection of consumers and animals;

CONSIDERING THAT the Quebec was the last province to enact its law to protect animals and that this law to this day contains no acceptable standards that protect animals;

CONSIDERING THAT the SPCA, with 137 years of experience, has managed to gain the confidence of more than 83% of the population (Léger Marketing January 2005);


CONSIDERING THAT the SPCA is willing to put at the disposal of the Quebec government its infrastructure, its expertise, as well as its qualified inspectors;

CONSIDERING THAT the SPCA offers a training and awareness program that would allow the expansion of these services throughout the province at no cost to the taxpayers;

Et l'intervention réclamée se résume ainsi;

This is why we, the undersigned, are asking the Quebec National Assembly to adopt a resolution mandating the SPCA and its affiliates with full power to apply the law concerning the well-being and the safety of animals Animal Health Protection Act (P-42), and to obtain from the government its firm commitment that it will create standards designed to protect the public and the animals.
